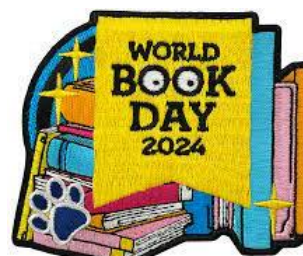
Summer's Easter Mission
